Materials Needed

Fat quarter each of D1570-504 Medium Flowers on Yellow, D1571-632 Pink Empress Woo, D1571-412 Blue Empress Woo, D1573-620 Pink Flower Clusters on Blue, D1571-504 Yellow Empress Woo

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard each of D1572-620 Large Flowers on Pink, D1573-412 Pink Flower Clusters on Blue, D1573-504 Pink Flower Clusters on Yellow, D1572-412 Large Flowers on Blue, D1570-412 Medium Flowers on Blue, D1570-620 Medium Flowers on Pink

D1576-458 Green Squiggle $\frac{7}{8}$ yd

D1572-504 Large Flowers on Yellow 2 yd

D1578-412 $\frac{5}{8}$ yd

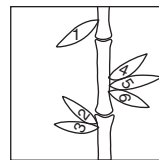
Backing fabric 4 yds

Green thread to match fabric for appliqué

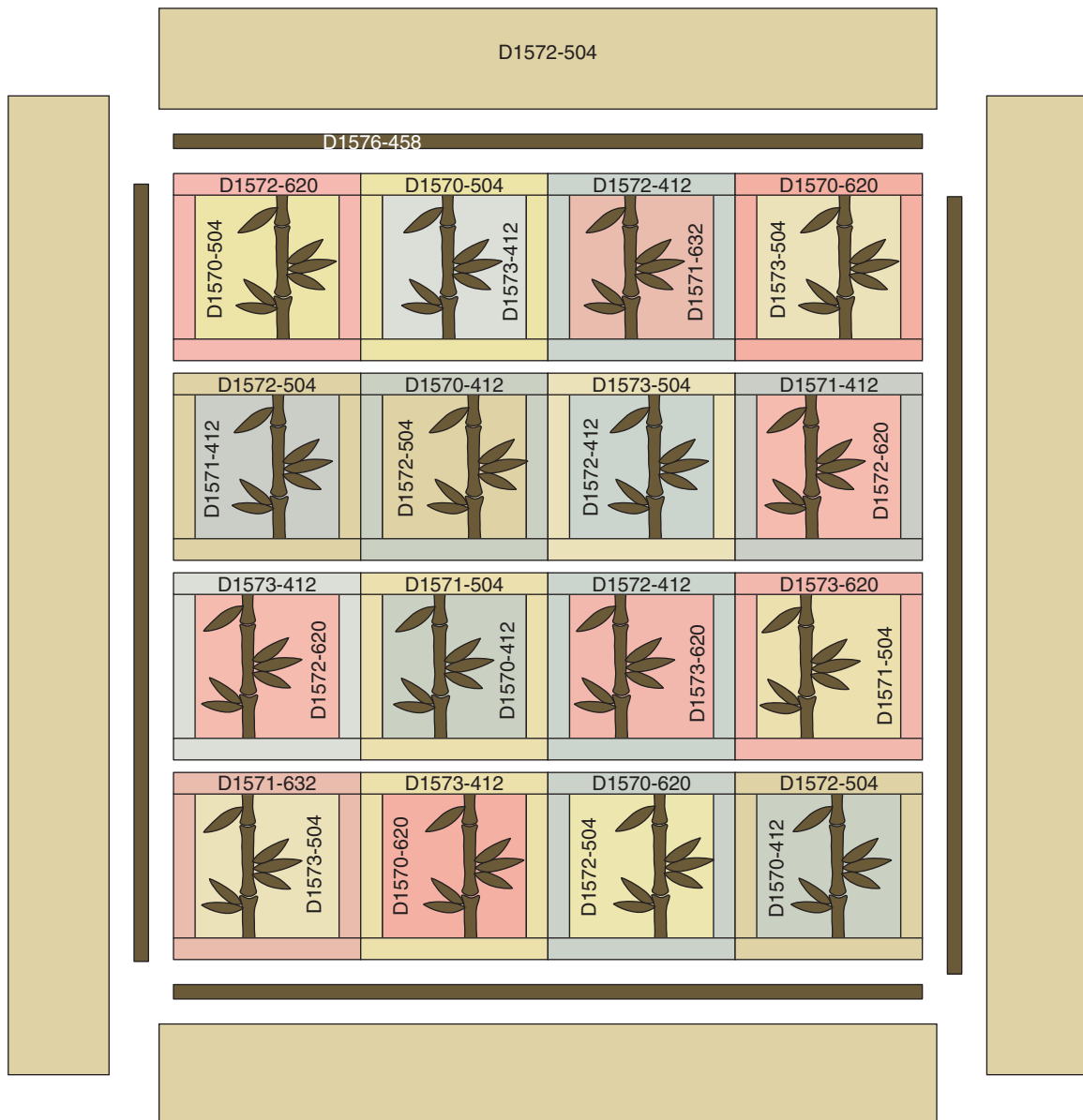
Template plastic

Cutting and Piecing

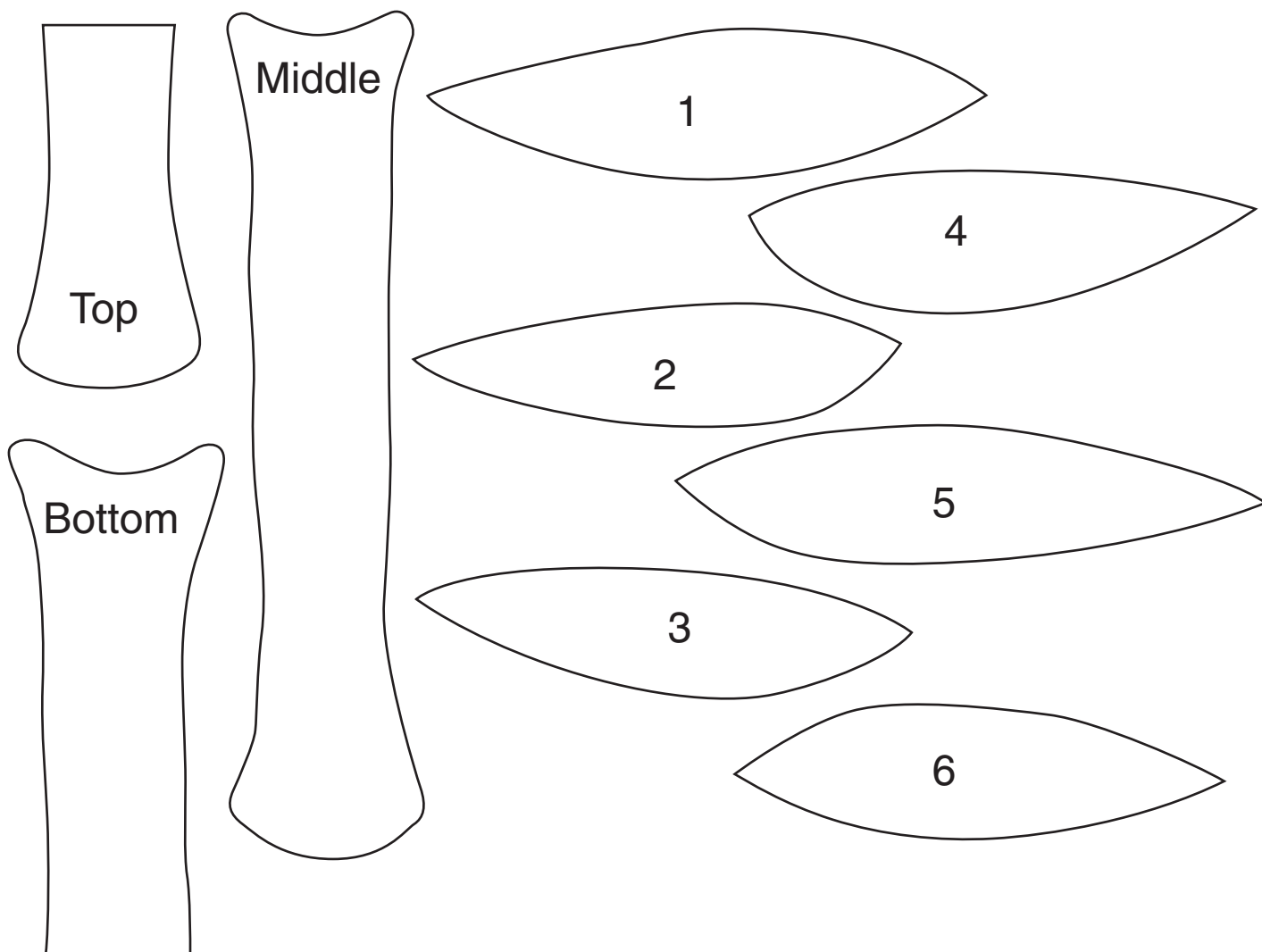
1. From each of the following fabrics cut 1 or 2 squares $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ ": D1570-504 (1), D1573-412 (1), D1571-632 (1), D1573-504 (2), D1571-412 (1), D1572-504 (2), D1572-412 (1), D1572-620 (2), D1570-412 (2), D1573-620 (1), D1571-504 (1), D1570-620 (1).
2. Print template page at 100% (some printers are set to print smaller.) The templates DO NOT have seam allowance. Trace leaves (6 different) and bamboo (3 parts) to template plastic.
3. Trace 16 of each leaf and 16 of each bamboo piece to D1576-458 Green. Add seam allowance if you will be turning edges under. Use your favorite appliqué technique to appliqué the leaves and bamboo to each $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Vary the position of the bamboo and leaves on blocks, placing them center, left, and right. Refer to photo or graphic on next page for placement, if needed.
4. From D1572-504 Large Flowers on Yellow, cut 4 strips $7\frac{1}{2}$ " x LENGTH of fabric before cutting any other pieces.



5. From each of the following fabrics cut strips 2" x 10½", and strips 2" x 13½". The number to cut is indicated after each fabric number. D1572-620 (2), D1570-504 (2), D1572-412 (4), D1570-620 (4), D1572-504 (4), D1570-412 (2), D1573-504 (2), D1571-412 (2), D1573-412 (4), D1571-504 (2), D1573-620 (2), D1571-632 (2).
 6. Stitch 10½" strips to the sides of each 10½" square. Stitch the 13½" strips to the top and bottom of each square.
 7. Piece blocks together into 4 rows, then piece the rows together. Follow the layout in the graphic below or use your own arrangement.
 8. From D1576-458 Green, cut 6 strips 1½" x width of fabric. Cut 2 strips in half and stitch one piece to each of the other 4 strips. Recut 2 strips to measure 1½" x 52½". Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.
9. Trim 2 of the 7½" strips cut previously to 7½" x 54½". Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt. Trim the remaining 2 strips to 7½" x 68½". Stitch to the sides of the quilt.
 10. From D1578-412 Blue, cut 8 strips 2½" x width of fabric. Stitch together to make 1 continuous strip for binding. Fold in half wrong sides together and press. Stitch to the front of the quilt, turn to the back and stitch in place by hand or machine.



Templates DO NOT include seam allowance. Print templates at 100%. Some printers are set to print at less than 100%. Check your settings before printing templates.
