This quilt is made of various blocks that can be interchanged in a variety of ways. This way your quilt can be your very own. I would love to see how you have done it...drop me a line at bluenickel5@earthlink.net so I can see what you have done with it.

- The Garden (Center) is made up of 7" x 10" blocks (A,B, & C) and 5" square blocks (D,E, & F)
- The Hedge (top and bottom borders) is made up of 6" square blocks (G,H, & I)
- The Forest (side borders) is made up of 5" x 10" blocks (J) with a random 2 ½ x 5 ½ spacer bar on each side.

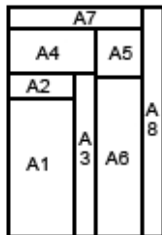
Fabric requirements—(you will have leftovers)

- 1/3 yard JY08 Teal
- ½ yard JY15 Purple
- 1/3 yard JY10 Lime
- 1/3 yard JY14 Pink
- 1/3 yard JY03 Rust
- ½ yard JY01 Pink
- 1/3 yard JY03 Green
- 1/3 yard JY05 Rust
- 5/8 yard JY16 Blue
- 1/3 yard JY11 Lime
- 1/3 yard JY14 Pink
- 1/3 yard JY02 Blue
- 5/8 yard JY05 Green
- 5/8 yard JY15 Teal
- 5/8 yard JY16 Green
- 5/8 yard JY13 Teal

Cutting and Piecing of individual blocks

Garden blocks (cutting instructions are for each single block)

- Block A (7.5" x 10.5" unfinished)—make 4 blocks
Cut one A1 3.5" x 6.5" –JY08 Teal
Cut one A2 1.5" x 3.5" –JY15 Purple
Cut one A3 1.5" x 7.5" –JY15 Purple
Cut one A4 2.5" x 4.5" –JY10 Lime
Cut one A5 2.5" x 2.5" – JY14 Pink
Cut one A6 2.5" x 7.5" – JY10 Lime
Cut one A7 1.5" x 6.5" –JY03 Rust
Cut one A8 1.5" x 10.5" –JY03 Rust
Piece in this order:
Add A2 to A1, then A3 to A2 & A1, then A4 to A2 & A3, A5 to A6, and then A5 & A6 to A4 & A3, then A7 to A4 & A5, then A8 to A7,A5,A6.....always press away from the A1 base.

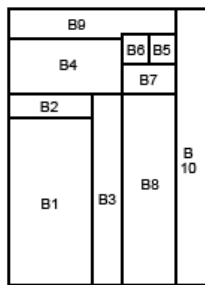


- Block B (7.5" x 10.5" unfinished)—make 4 blocks

Cut one B1 3.5" x 6.5" –JY01 Pink
 Cut one B2 1.5" x 3.5" –JY03 Green
 Cut one B3 1.5" x 7.5" –JY03 Green
 Cut one B4 2.5" x 4.5" –JY05 Rust
 Cut one B5 1.5" x 1.5" –JY01 Pink
 Cut one B6 1.5" x 1.5" –JY03 Green
 Cut one B7 1.5" x 2.5" –JY03 Green
 Cut one B8 2.5" x 7.5" – JY05 Rust
 Cut one B9 1.5" x 6.5" –JY16 Blue
 Cut one B10 1.5"x10,5" –JY16 Blue

Piece in this order:

Unit I – B2 to B1, then B3 to B2 & B1, then B4 to B2 & B3. Unit II – B5 to B6, then B7 to B5 & B6, then B8 to B7. Sew Unit I to Unit II as shown in diagram then at B9 to the top and B10 to the side.

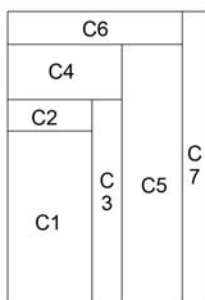


- Block C (7.5" x 10.5" unfinished)—Make 4 blocks

Cut one C1 3.5" x 6.5" –JY11 Lime
 Cut one C2 1.5" x 3.5" –JY14 Pink
 Cut one C3 1.5" x 7.5" –JY14 Pink
 Cut one C4 2.5" x 4.5" – JY02 Blue
 Cut one C5 2.5" x 9.5" –JY02 Blue
 Cut one C6 1.5" x 6.5" –JY15 Purple
 Cut one C7 1.5" x 10.5" –JY15 Purple

Piece in this order:

Add C2 to C1, then add C3 to C2 & C1, then add C4 to C2 & C3, then add C5 to C4 and C3, then add C6 to C4 & C5, finally adding C7 to C6 and C5.



- Block D (5.5" x 5.5" unfinished) – Make 8 blocks

Cut one D1 2.5" x 2.5" – JY10 Lime

Cut one D2 1.5" x 2.5" –JY02 Blue

Cut one D3 1.5" x 3.5" –JY02 Blue

Cut one D4 1.5" x 3.5" –JY14 Pink

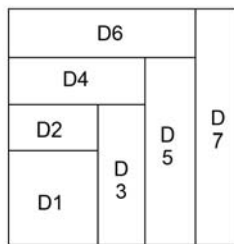
Cut one D5 1.5" x 4.5" –JY14 Pink

Cut one D6 1.5" x 4.5" –JY03 Green

Cut one D7 1.5" x 5.5" –JY03 Green

Piece in this order:

Add D2 to D1, then D3 to D2 & D1, then D4 to D2 & D3, then D5 to D4 and D3, then D6 to D4 & D5, finally D7 to D6 and D5.



- Block E (Easy!) (5.5" x 5.5" unfinished) – Make 8 blocks

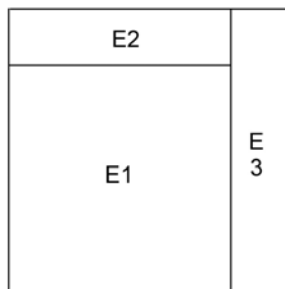
Cut one E1 4.5" x 4.5" –JY11 Lime

Cut one E2 1.5" x 4.5" –JY15 Purple

Cut one E3 1.5 x 5.5" –JY15 Purple

Piece in this order:

Add E2 to E1, then add E3 to E2 & E1



...told you it was easy!!

- Block F (5.5"x 5.5" unfinished) – Make 8 blocks

Cut one F1 3.5" x 3.5" –JY01 Pink

Cut one F2 1.5" x 3.5" –JY16 Blue

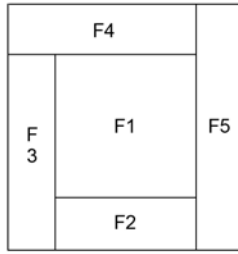
Cut one F3 1.5" x 4.5" –JY16 Blue

Cut one F4 1.5" x 5.5" –JY05 Rust

Cut one F5 1.5" x 6.5" –JY05 Rust

Piece in this order:

Add F2 to F1, then F3 to F1 & F2, then F4 to F3 & F1, then F5 to F4, F1, and F2.



Hedge blocks (cutting instructions are for each single block)

- Block G (6.5" x 6.5" unfinished) – Make 4

Cut one G1 4.5" x 4.5" –JY05 Green

Cut one G2 1.5" x 4.5" –JY16 Blue

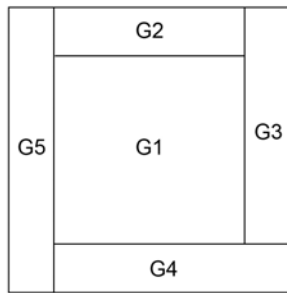
Cut one G3 1.5" x 5.5" –JY16 Blue

Cut one G4 1.5" x 5.5" –JY02 Blue

Cut one G5 1.5" x 6.5" –JY02 Blue

Piece in this order:

Add G2 to G1, then G3 to G1 & G2, then G4 to G1 & G3, then G5 to G1, G4, & G2.



- Block H (6.5" x 6.5" unfinished) – Make 4

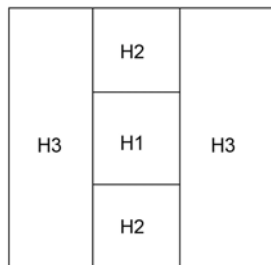
Cut one H1 2.5" x 2.5" –JY15 Teal

Cut two H2 2.5" x 2.5" –JY05 Rust

Cut two H3 2.5" x 6.5" –JY05 Rust

Piece in this order:

Add H2 to the top and bottom of H1, then add H3 to both sides of the H2-H1-H2 unit.



- Block I (6.5" x 6.5" unfinished) – Make 4

Cut one I1 3.5" x 3.5" –JY15 Purple

Cut one I2 1.5" x 3.5" –JY11 Lime

Cut one I3 1.5" x 4.5" –JY11 Lime

Cut one I4 1.5" x 4.5" –JY16 Green

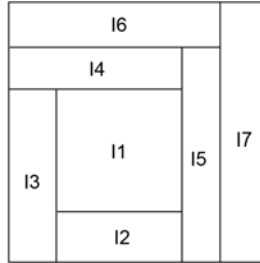
Cut one I5 1.5" x 5.5" –JY16 Green

Cut one I6 1.5" x 5.5" –JY01 Pink

Cut one I7 1.5" x 6.5" –JY01 Pink

Piece in this order:

Add I2 to I1, then I3 to I2 & I1, then I4 to I3 & I1, then I5 to I4,I1, & I2, then I6 to I4 & I5, finally I7 to I6 & I5.



Forest blocks (cutting instructions are for each single block)

- Block J (5.5" x 10.5" unfinished – Make 10

Cut four J1 1.5" x 1.5"—various scraps.

Cut two J2 2.5" x 4.5" – JY05 Green or JY16 Green

(I did 5 sets of each in mine)

Cut two J3 2.5" x 5.5" – JY05 Green or JY16 Green

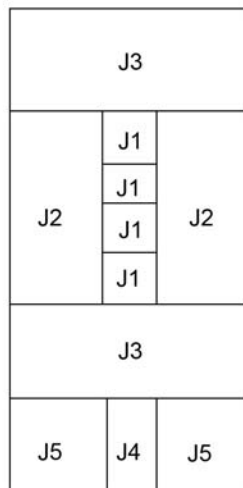
(I did 5 sets of each in mine)

Cut one J4 1.5" X 2.5" –JY03 Rust

Cut two J5 2.5" x 2.5" – JY13 Teal or JY15 Teal

(I did 5 sets of each in mine)

Piece in this order: Sew the four J1's together in a row, then add a J2 to each side of the row of J1's, then add a J3 to top and bottom of this unit. Sew a J5 to each side of J4 and add this to the bottom of the J1,J2,J3 unit. (see diagram)



Putting the blocks together:

Take two of the 5.5" blocks D,E, or F and sew them together creating a 5.5" x 10.5" unit.

Then sew one of the 7.5" x 10.5" blocks A,B, or C to either side of this unit. (see layout below for exact placement, or make it your own by varying which blocks you put together) You should have a 12.5" x 10.5" block. Using the rest of you're A-F blocks make 11 more of these 12.5" x 10.5" blocks.

Combine these Garden blocks into 4 rows of 3 each and join together. (see layout)

Then add 6 of the Hedge blocks (G,H, and I) in a row across the top and the bottom of these twelve blocks. (see layout)

Now add 5 Forest blocks (J) vertically on both sides, randomly placing a 2.5" x 5.5" piece of JY13 Teal or JY15 Teal. (see layout)

Quilt as desired and bind with scraps of any of the blues you have leftover.
