Birdy Quilt

FABRIC	YARDAGE	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Tree panel	1 yard panel	fussy cut, centering tree approximately 28" w x 30" h
Multi-colored stripe	Fat 1/3	(13) 4-1/2" squares
Bumblebees on cream	Fat 1/4	(3) 4-1/2" squares (fussy cut to capture flying bee)
Pink Dot	Fat 1/8 each	(10) 2-1/2" squares
Green Dot	Fat 1/8 each	(10) 2-1/2" squares
Blue with pink flower	Fat 1/8 each	(11) 2-1/2" squares
Plain cream	extra from panel edges	(32) 2-1/2" squares
Butterfly border	1 yard	(1) fussy cut height x width of quilt
Posies and Bees border	1 yard	(1) fussy cut height x width of quilt
Bumblebees on cream	1/3 yard	(4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips
Backing/Batting	3 yards	

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Patchwork side borders: Sew random combinations of (2) 2-1/2" colored squares with (2) 2-1/2" cream squares to make a 4-patch block. Make sure to have two cream squares diagonal from each other; refer to picture when needed.

Sew one 4-1/2" stripe square to one 4-patch block. Make (7) sets with the stripe square on the left and (6) sets with the stripe square on the right. Sew one 4-1/2" Bumblebee on cream square to one 4-patch block. Make (3) sets. Refer to photo for layout 8 rows for each side. Sew rows together. Sew group to left side of panel and one group to right side of panel. Trim to square top and bottom.

Borders: Measure width of quilt and cut your top and bottom borders. Sew "Butterfly border" to the top of the quilt and "Posies and Bees border" to the bottom of the quilt.

Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt. Bind with "Bumblebees on cream" strips.
