

Picnic Parade

Picnic Parade fabric collection from Posh Pattern by Jenean for FreeSpirit.

Quilt by Mimi Shimp.

Approximate size: 63" x 63"



Materials Needed

JM22 Grenadine (A); JM12 Blue (B); JM20 Lime (C);
 JM12 Beetroot (D); JM21 Blue (E) 1 yard each
 HJM18 Blue (Binding) 1 yard
 Backing 3½ yards
 Acrylic Ruler, mat, rotary cutter, sewing machine, scissors


Cutting and Piecing Directions

1. From each fabric A-E, cut 9 strips 3½" x WOF.
2. Make strip sets as shown to the right, and following the chart for combinations. Stitch 2 strips together, press seams open, then stitch third strip to set. Press seams open.

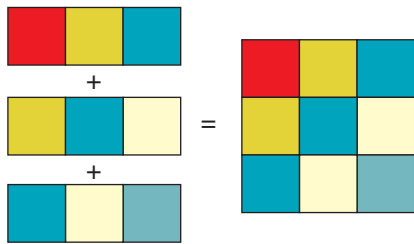


Strip Set Chart

	Fabrics	# Sets
Strip Set 1	A-C-B	2
Strip Set 2	C-B-D	2
Strip Set 3	B-D-E	2
Strip Set 4	D-E-A	2
Strip Set 5	E-A-C	2
Strip Set 6	E-A-E	1
Strip Set 7	A-C-A	1
Strip Set 8	C-B-C	1
Strip Set 9	B-D-B	1
Strip Set 10	D-E-D	1

3. Cross-cut all strip sets into 3½" x 9½" segments. 

4. Following the chart to the right, make 9 patches as shown. Stitch segments together to complete a 9-patch block.

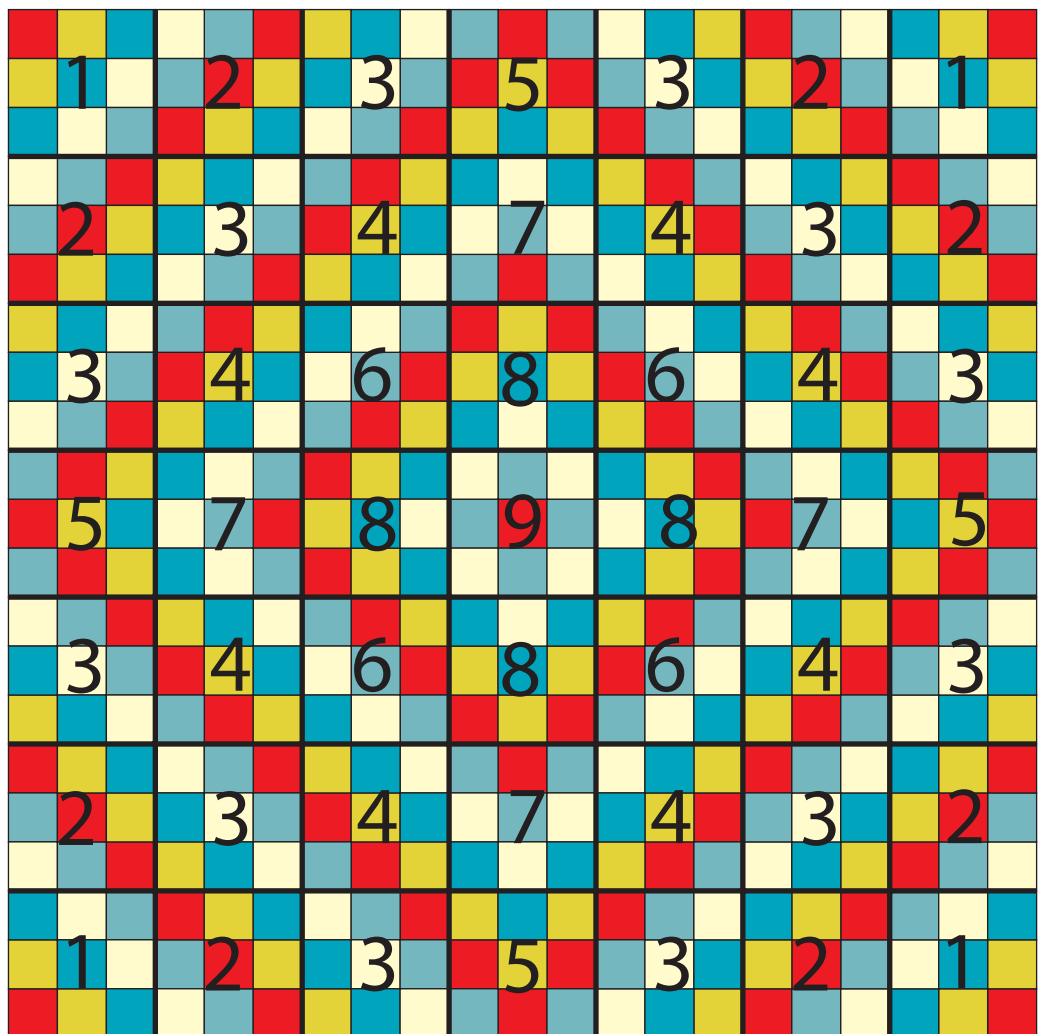


Nine Patch Blocks

	Strip Set Segment	# Blocks
Block 1	1-2-3	4
Block 2	4-5-1	8
Block 3	2-3-4	12
Block 4	5-1-2	8
Block 5	6-7-8	4
Block 6	3-4-5	4
Block 7	9-10-6	4
Block 8	7-8-9	4
Block 9	10-6-10	1

5. Following the layout below right, stitch 9-patches together into rows, then stitch rows together. Press seams of each row in one direction.

6. Layer, quilt, and bind. Cut binding strips 2½" x WOF, on the bias if using the stripe. Stich strips together to make one continuous strip of binding.



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
