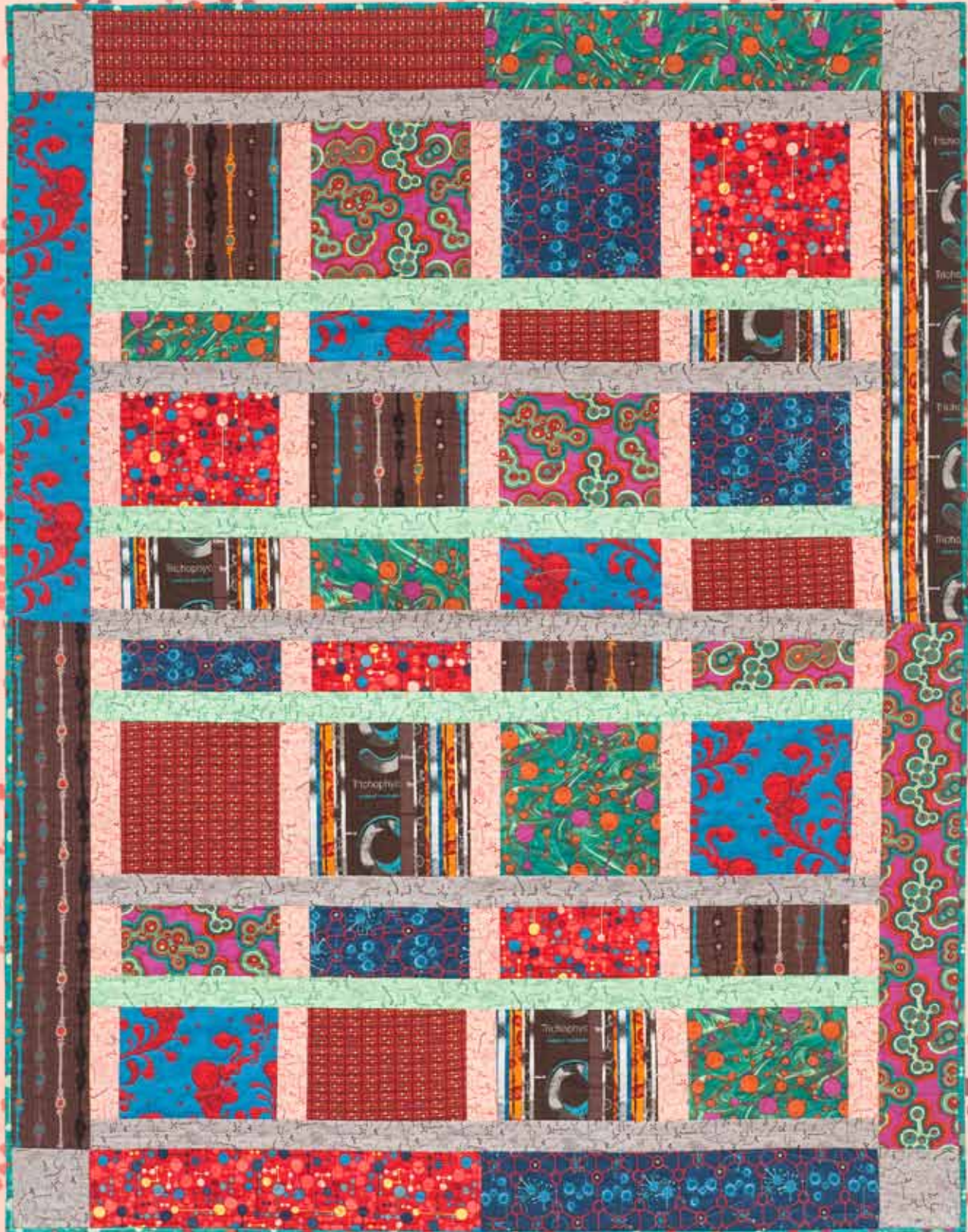


# Germania Quilt

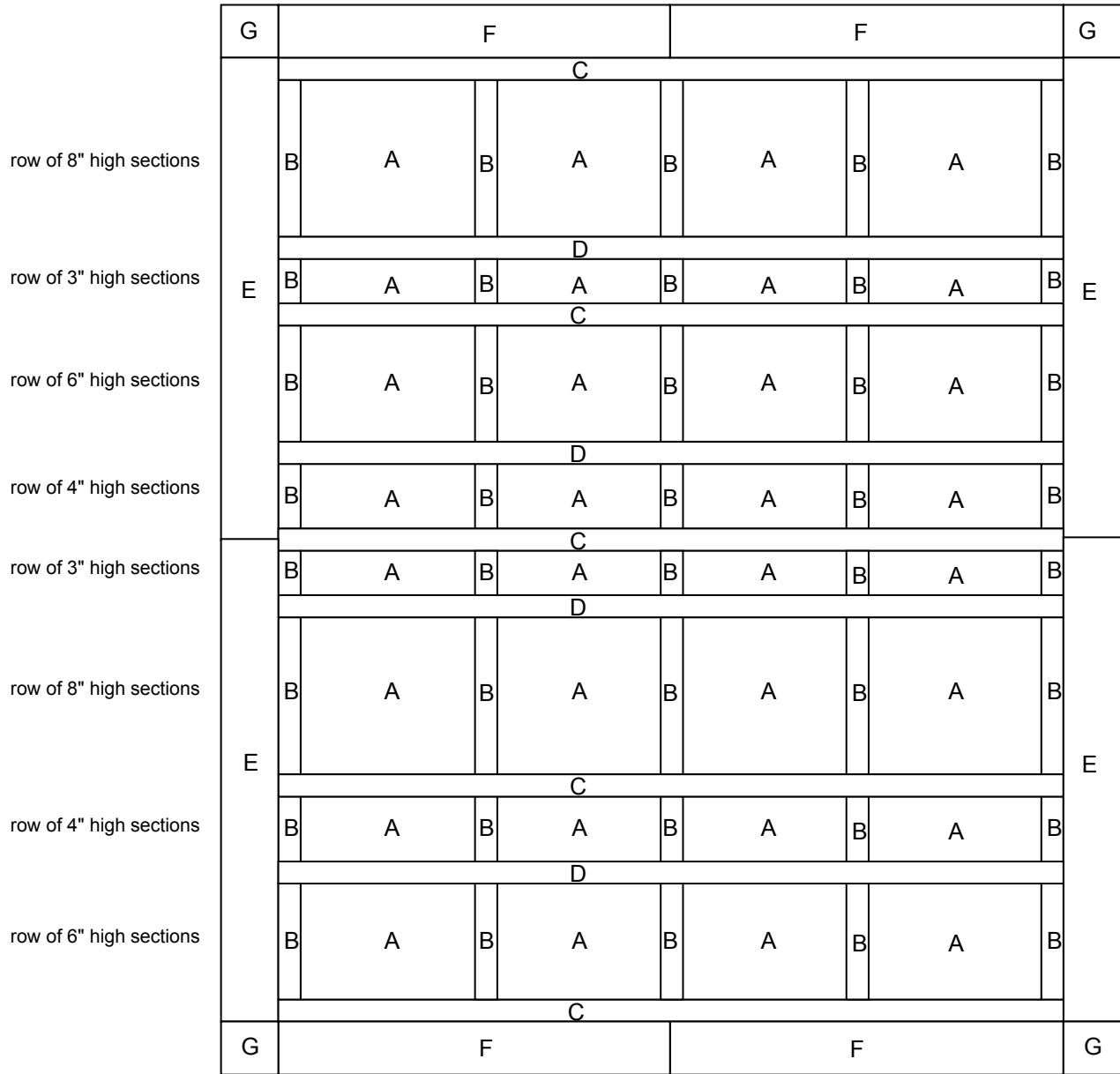

QUILT SIZE: 48" X 60"

## YARDAGE

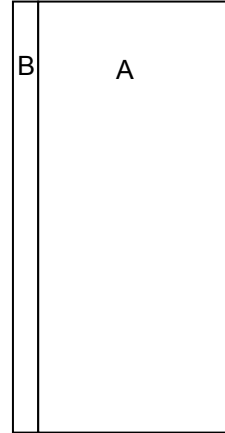
A (main blocks), E (side borders), F (top & bottom borders)	5/8 yard each of ( 8 ) different fabrics
B (vertical lattice)	5/8 yard
C (horizontal lattice)	3/8 yard
D (alternating horizontal lattice)	3/8 yard
G (border corner stones)	10" x 10" square
Backing	54" x 66"

## CUTTING

A (main blocks)	cut ( 1 ) 8 1/2" x 21" strip from each of the "A/E/F" fabrics for a total of ( 8 ) strips
B (vertical lattice)	cut ( 8 ) 2" x 21" strips cut ( 2 ) 2" x 8" strips cut ( 2 ) 2" x 6" strips cut ( 2 ) 2" x 4" strips cut ( 2 ) 2" x 3" strips
C (horizontal lattice)	cut ( 5 ) 2" x 40" strips
D (alternating horizontal lattice)	cut ( 4 ) 2" x 40" strips
E (side borders)	cut ( 1 ) 4 1/2" x 26 1/4" strip from four of the "A/E/F" fabrics
F (top & bottom borders)	cut ( 1 ) 4 1/2" x 20 1/4" strip from the four remaining "A/E/F" fabrics
G (border corner stones)	cut ( 4 ) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares

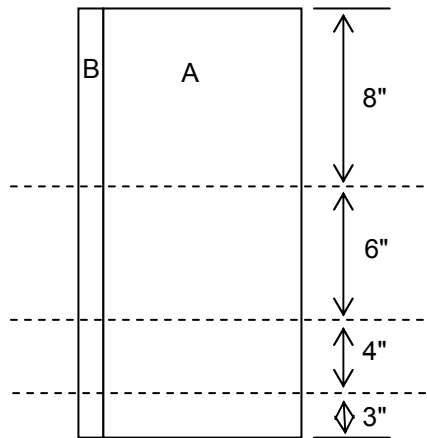
## SEWING

Sew each A strip to each of the 2" x 21" B strips.  
Repeat for each A & B strip for a total of ( 8 ) sets.



As shown, recut each A/B set into:

- ( 1 ) 8" high section
- ( 1 ) 6" high section
- ( 1 ) 4" high section
- ( 1 ) 3" high section



You will now have ( 8 ) of each size; one of each A fabric in each of the ( 4 ) sizes.

Sew rows of "blocks" according to Placement Diagram, adding the appropriate length B to end of each row.

Sew rows to horizontal lattice as shown in Placement Diagram.

Sew the short ends of two E strips to form a side border. Repeat for a second border.

Sew the short ends of two F strips to form the top border. Repeat for the bottom border.

Sew a G corner stone to each end of the top and bottom borders.

Sew borders onto body of quilt.
