Fabric requirements—(you will have leftovers—try incorporating them into the back!!)

- one panel of BA10 Grey
- 1 fat 1/8th of BA15 Green
- 1 fat 1/4 (or 1/3 yd to fussy cut) of BA12 Black
- 1 fat 1/4 of BA14 Green
- 1 fat 1/4 (or 1/3 yd to fussy cut) of BA17 Green
- 1 fat 1/8th of BA18 Tan
- 3/4 yard of BA16 Red
- 1 fat 1/8th of BA15 Blue
- 1 fat 1/4 (or 1/3 yd to fussy cut) of BA12 Red
- 1 fat 1/4 (or 1/3 yd to fussy cut) of BA13 Blue
- 1 fat 1/4 (or 1/3 yd to fussy cut) of BA17 Grey
- 1 fat 1/8th of BA18 Red
- 3/4 yd of BA16 Gold
- 1-1/2 yards BA13 Green (for piecing and binding)
- 3.5 yards backing fabric of your choice. (or less if you include your scraps from the front)

In all instructions 1/4" seams are assumed throughout this pattern.

Create the borders—First!

Yes, this is unusual, but for this quilt you are going to create the borders first as they have the most piecing and you will need some of the scraps for the medallion.

Top and Bottom Borders A and B

Border A – cutting instructions for one unit (make 2)

- Cut one 3.5" x 10.5" piece A of BA15 Green
- Cut two 2.5" x 8.5" piece B of BA12 Black
- Cut two 2.5" x 6.5" piece C of BA14 Green
- Cut two 2" x 5.5" piece D of BA17 Green
- Cut two 2.5" x 4.5" piece E of BA18 Tan
- Cut two 2.5" x 2.5" piece F of BA17 Green
- Cut two 2.5" x 8.5" piece G, two 2.5" x 6.5" piece H, two 2" x 5.5" piece I, two 2.5" x 4.5" piece J, two 2.5" x 2.5" piece K all from BA16 Red.

Sew and press F to G creating 2 F/G pieces

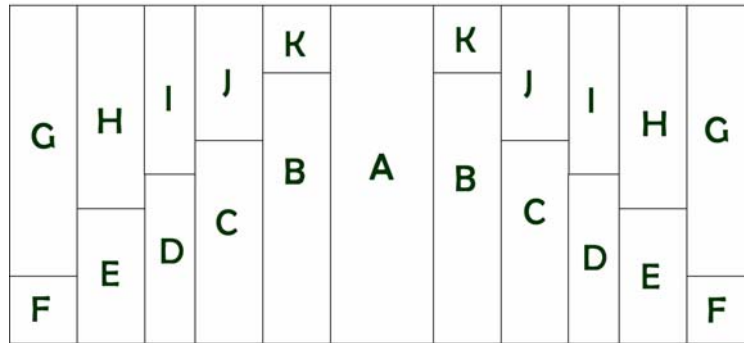
Sew and press E to H creating 2 E/H pieces

Sew and press D to I creating 2 D/I pieces

Sew and press C to J creating 2 C/J pieces

Sew and press B to K creating 2 B/K pieces

Sew these combo units side to each other side by side as diagramed below:



Border B – cutting instructions for one unit (make 2)

- Cut one 3.5” x 10.5” piece A of BA15 Blue
- Cut two 2.5” x 8.5” piece B of BA12 Red
- Cut two 2.5” x 6.5” piece C of BA13 Blue
- Cut two 2” x 5.5” piece D of BA17 Grey
- Cut two 2.5” x 4.5” piece E of BA18 Red
- Cut two 2.5” x 2.5” piece F of BA17 Grey
- Cut two 2.5” x 8.5” piece G, two 2.5” x 6.5” piece H, two 2” x 5.5” piece I, two 2.5” x 4.5” piece J, two 2.5” x 2.5” piece K all from BA16 Gold.

Sew and press F to G creating 2 F/G pieces

Sew and press E to H creating 2 E/H pieces

Sew and press D to I creating 2 D/I pieces

Sew and press C to J creating 2 C/J pieces

Sew and press B to K creating 2 B/K pieces

Sew these combo units side to each other as diagrammed above for Border A.

Sew one Border A to one Border B for the top border and do the same for the bottom border. See photo for reference.

Side Borders C and D

Border C – cutting instructions for one unit (make 3)

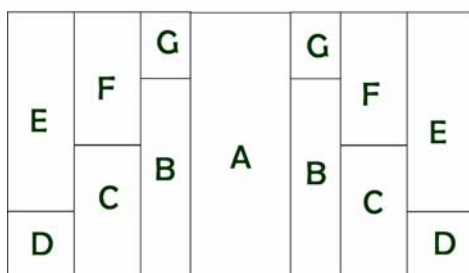
- Cut one 3.5” x 8.5” piece A of BA12 Red
- Cut two 2” x 6.5” piece B of BA17 Grey
- Cut two 2.5” x 4.5” piece C of BA13 Blue
- Cut two 2.5” x 2.5” piece D of BA18 Red
- Cut two 2.5” x 6.5” piece E, two 2.5” x 4.5” piece F, and two 2.5” x 2.5” piece G of BA16 Gold

Sew and press B to G creating 2 B/G pieces

Sew and press C to F creating 2 C/F pieces

Sew and press D to E creating 2 D/E pieces

Sew these combo units side by side as diagrammed below:



Border D – cutting instructions for one unit (make 3)

- Cut one 3.5” x 8.5” piece A of BA12 Black
- Cut two 2” x 6.5” piece B of BA17 Green
- Cut two 2.5” x 4.5” piece C of BA14 Green
- Cut two 2.5” x 2.5” piece D of BA18 Tan
- Cut two 2.5” x 6.5” piece E, two 2.5” x 4.5” piece F, and two 2.5” x 2.5” piece G of BA16 Red

Sew and press B to G creating 2 B/G pieces

Sew and press C to F creating 2 C/F pieces

Sew and press D to E creating 2 D/E pieces

Sew these combo units side by side in as diagrammed above for Border C.

Sew two Border C units to each side of one Border D unit and sew the remaining two Border D units to each side of the remaining Border C unit. See photo for reference. Now you have the two side borders.

The Corner Blocks E

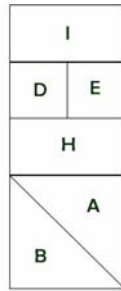
Corner E – cutting instructions for all four units

- Cut two 4 7/8” x 4 7/8” squares then cut in half diagonally once for a total of four half-square triangle A of BA16 Red
- Cut two 4 7/8” x 4 7/8” squares then cut in half diagonally once for a total of four half-square triangle B of BA16 Gold
- Cut four 4 7/8” x 4 7/8” squares then cut in half diagonally once for a total of eight half-square triangle C of BA13 Green to get the stripes to match as in photo, place two of the squares with the stripes laying horizontally and two of the squares with the stripes laying vertically before cutting in half diagonally.
- Cut eight 2.5” x 2.5” square D of BA13 Blue
- Cut four 2.5” x 2.5” square E of BA16 Red
- Cut four 2.5” x 2.5” square F of BA16 Gold
- Cut four 2.5” x 4.5” piece G of BA16 Gold
- Cut four 2.5” x 4.5” piece H of BA16 Red
- Cut eight 2.5” x 4.5” piece I of BA13 Green

Sew and press A to B, sew C to C matching up stripes as in the photo.

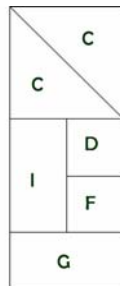
Sew and press D to E, then sew and press D/E unit to H and I, referring to the diagram below.

Then sew I/D/E/H unit to A/B unit as in diagram below.

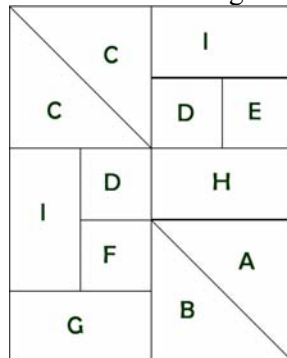


Sew and press D to E then sew D/E unit to I, then sew D/E/I unit to H, referring to the diagram below.

Then sew D/E/I/H unit to C/C unit as in diagram below.



Sew these two units to each other as in diagram below. Make four of these.



The center medallion

- Cut the Rebel panel BA10 Grey to 40" wide by 34" high
- From scraps leftover from the border and corner units cut five 4.5" x 4.5" squares and twenty 2.5" x 2.5" squares—from the twenty 2.5" squares sew five 4-patch units. Then sew these 4-patch units to the 4.5" squares as seen in the photo of the quilt. Sew this row of patches across the bottom of the Rebel panel.
- From BA13 Green cut four 2.5" strips WOF and re-cut two of them to 40.5" and two of them to 42.5" for the inner border surrounding this medallion piece. Sew & press the 40.5" pieces to the top and bottom and then sew & press the 42.5" strips to the sides.

Putting it all together

Now that you have all the units done, let's finish it up. Sew and press one corner unit (E) to each side of the top and bottom borders (A and B units). See photo for reference. Then sew the side borders (C and D units) to the side of the medallion. See photo for reference here too. Then sew the top and bottom border/corner units (E/A/B/E) to the top and bottom of the Medallion-side border units, and you are done with piecing the top.

Quilt the top and then bind it with your favorite method using BA13 Green

Don't forget to include a label!!
