Fabrics needed:



1 yard DF73 Black



¼ yard DF74 Black



3/8 yard DF77 Black



¾ yard DF79 Black



¾ yard DF78 Black



1 ¾ yards DF70 Black



2/3 yard DF71 Black

4 yards backing fabric

72" x 72" batting

Cutting:

From DF73 Black:

1 – 8 ½" x 8 ½" (center block)

8 – 2 ½" x 2 ½" (setting corners)

4 – 6 ½" x 6 ½" (outer setting corners)

6 – 2 ¼" by wof (binding) (fussy cut design)

From DF74 Black:

2 – 6 ½" x 6 ½", 2nd cut on diagonal = 4 pcs.

From DF77 Black:

2 – 12" x 12", 2nd cut on diagonal = 4 pcs.

From DF79 Black:

2 – 21" x 21", 2nd cut on diagonal = 4 pcs.

From DF78 Black:

4 – 4 ½" x 37" (fussy cut design)

From DF70 Black:

4 – 5 ½" x length of fabric (fussy cut design)

From DF71 Black:

4 – 2 ½" x 12"

4 – 2 ½" x 22 ½"

4 – 2 ½" x 37"

Construction:

Begin building this quilt with the 8 ½" x 8 ½" center square from fabric DF73.

Then follow the steps!

Step 1: Add the 4 half square triangles of fabric DF74 – sewing 2 opposite sides first & then the last 2.

Step 2: Add 2 of the stripe pieces (DF71) – 2 ½" x 12" – to opposite sides of the above square.

Step 3: Add 2 of the 2 ½" squares (DF73) to opposite ends of the remaining stripe pieces – 2 ½" x 12"

Step 4: Add these to the center square.

Step 5: Continue by adding 4 half square triangles (DF77) in the same manner.

Step 6: Add 4 stripe sections – 2 ½" x 22 ½" – including 4 – 2 ½" squares (DF73) – just like above!

Step 7: Add 4 half square triangles (DF79).

Step 8: Sew together stripe fabric (2 ½" x 37") and pink/black fabric (4 ½" x 37). Repeat 3 times.

Step 9: On 2 of the above strips – sew the 4 – 6 ½" squares (DF73) – to each end.

Step 10: Sew the two strips sets without $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares on the ends to opposite sides of the quilt top and bottom.

Step 11: Add the 2 additional strip sets to complete this border.

Step 12: The 4 – $5\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (DF70) are the outer border. Cut the strips for lengthwise –
2 – $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50", 2 – $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60".

Layer, quilt, bind and ENJOY!!
