## Puppy Dogs and Balls 43" x 61"

### Fabric Supply List:

7/8 yd. AT45 Sky  
1/3 yd. AT42 Yellow  
1/3 yd. AT44 Pumpkin  
1/3 yd. AT44 Yellow  
1/3 yd. AT46 Sky  
1/3 yd. AT42 Blue  
1/3 yd. AT47 Sky  
1 1/3 yd. AT48 Blue  
1 7/8 yd. AT47 – backing  
1 yd. Steam A Seam

### Cutting & Sewing Directions:

Please refer to picture of quilt for placement of blocks.

- From AT48 Blue cut center panel 43" wide x 45" long.
- From AT45 Sky cut (2) 2 1/2" x 43" strips for borders. Sew to top and bottom for center panel. (First border.)
- From AT45 Sky also cut 2 1/2" bias strips for binding.
- From each 1/3 yd. piece cut 1 strip 3 7/8" the WOF. Sub cut this strip in to (10) 3 7/8" squares. These will be used to make the pinwheel blocks.
  - First – make half-square triangle blocks.

With a pencil and ruler, draw a line on the wrong side of half of your squares, the lighter ones, from corner to opposite corner. With right sides together, layer the lighter square on the darker square and stitch a 1/4" inch seam on BOTH SIDES of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press seams allowances toward the dark fabric. Trim points.
- Pinwheel blocks – arrange 4 half square triangle blocks to make pinwheels. You should have 4 orange pinwheel blocks, 5 yellow pinwheels and 5 polka dot pinwheels. These blocks should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square.

- The remainder of the 1/3 yd. pieces will be used for the circles in the center panel. Iron steam a seam to the wrong side of each of the fabrics and cut 2", 3", 4" and 5" circles.
- Iron circles on to center panel and stitch around edges.  
\*\*Circles can be stacked one on top of the other or be used as a single circle. Use a decorative stitch to attach the circles on to the center panel.
- Sew 7 pinwheel blocks together (make two) and sew one row to the top of panel and one row to the bottom. (Second border.)
- Layer top, batting and backing. Quilt, add binding and wha lah you have the cutest little doggie quilt.
